6 SEC. 2. NO IMMUNITY FOR CERTAIN AIRPORT SCREENING
7 <b>METHODS.</b>
8 No law of the United States shall be construed to

9 confer any immunity for a Federal employee or agency or

- 1 any individual or entity that receives Federal funds, who
- 2 subjects an individual to any physical contact (including
- 3 contact with any clothing the individual is wearing), x-
- 4 rays, or millimeter waves, or aids in the creation of or
- 5 views a representation of any part of a individual's body
- 6 covered by clothing as a condition for such individual to
- 7 be in an airport or to fly in an aircraft. The preceding
- 8 sentence shall apply even if the individual or the individ-
- 9 ual's parent, guardian, or any other individual gives con-
- 10 sent.
